ABOUT OUR SCHOOL :

“Education breeds confidence, Confidence breeds hope, and Hope breeds peace”. To impart the knowledge, and confidence, in the puples mind, Nirmala CBSE school was started in the year 2015 with the inspiration of CSA central Governing body and by the Superior Genral, Rev. Sr.Roselinda vazhapally, Asst General Rev.Sr. Japamala Vatty, who supported for the growth of the Nirmala School to succeed in all the ventures, “A, dream becomes a goal when action is taken toward its achievements”. Within three years a dreams became action by our Guntur Provincial Rev. Sr. K. Sundari Garu and Vice Provincial Rev. Sr. T. Sujatha the Principal of Nirmala High school and CBSE. The new building has come up within a period of time and put on with spacious and good infrastructure.

The new building was opened in the name of NIRMALA CBSE School on 3rd June 2017 blessed by Most Rev. Chinnabathini Bhagyaiah Bishop of Guntur Diocese and inaugurated by Rev. Sr. Roselinda Vazhapally Superior General of CSA and Guntur Provincial Rev. Sr. K.Sundari garu and Vice Provincial Rev. Sr. T. Sujatha and many priests, and sisters presented on that day to grace the occasion.

SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE :

Nirmala CBSE School has started its commencement with strength of 565 students, 4 Sisters and 25 teachers well trained and experienced. There are 5, class four employees and we have 15 supporting staff including drivers, assistants, and security. The main motto of the school is serving with love, to provide accurate education which involves many kinds of programmes and activities.

The school building was constructed with 4- storied building .with 28 class rooms, one computer lab with 25 working systems including with projector. There is physics lab, biology lab, social lab and maths lab. We have a full-fledged Library with three thousand books. It is a boost which drives our students to learn, develop the power of concentration and inculcates love of reading. “Enter the magical world of learning to make learning easy”. So the school has 21 Smart class rooms with two different servers that is “Tata Class edge” and “Educomp”., which helps the students to improve their knowledge through the visuals and pictures and empower teachers to transform from using traditional blackboard and chalks to eco-friendly electronic aids. It made learning smart. The school has a mineral water plant for drinking water, a huge lavishing playground giving an appearance of a mini stadium with Kho - Kho, Basketball, Volleyball, throw ball courts and a separate Kindergarten park.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS AND WORKSHOPS :






In the month of October, the members of CSA Education Committee inspected the school in the aspects of the Academics and the Administration.
